ANSWER:	Adjacent to the outdoors refers to a room with a wall(s), a floor or roof enclosure element that is part of the building envelope. Slab on grade floors are not considered adjacent to the outdoors. The roof enclosure must be directly over the mechanical room with no intervening floor separations.
