STATE BUILDING CODE INTERPRETATION NO. 14-01

- **CODE:** 2012 Washington State Energy Code, Commercial
- **SECTION:** C101.4.3 Additions, alterations, renovation or repair C402.4.1.2.3 Air leakage, Building test
- **QUESTION:** If an alteration, renovation or repair includes envelope assemblies, is this area required to be tested for air leakage?
- ANSWER: No, air leakage testing is not intended for alterations or repairs as long as the alteration does not include a change in use or change in *space conditioning*.
