## STATE BUILDING CODE INTERPRETATION NO. 14-04

**CODE:** 2012 Washington State Energy Code, Commercial

**SECTION:** C402.5 Walk-in Coolers and Walk-in freezers

C402.6 Refrigerated Warehouse Coolers & Warehouse Freezers

**QUESTION:** These sections define the minimum allowable prescriptive R-values

for the walls, ceilings, doors and floors. There is no mention of equivalent prescriptive U-factors or component performance. Is the prescriptive R-value compliance path the only allowable path for this

space type?

ANSWER: Yes; however, alternate methods may be used if approved by the

building official.
