STATE BUILDING CODE INTERPRETATION NO. 16-03

CODE: 2015 International Building Code

SECTION: Table 2902.1/Minimum number of fixtures

QUESTION: 1) Is it the intent of this amendment to apply the "100 square feet gross

building area per student" to the entire group E occupancy building including office and assembly use/occupancies within the group E

occupancy?

2) Does Table 2902.1 Minimum Number of Required Plumbing Fixtures,

Footnote e supersede Section 2902.1.1 Fixture Calculations?

ANSWER: 1) Yes. The intent is to calculate the number of students based on the

gross floor area, within the Group E occupancy. This also includes any Group E accessory use, e.g., office space, unless separated.

2) No. The fixture calculation specified in 2902.1.1 still applies, by first

determining the occupant load per footnote e for Group E.
