STATE BUILDING CODE INTERPRETATION 17-16

CODE: 2015 International Building Code

SECTION: 304 Group B // 2902.1/2902.3 Toilet facilities

QUESTION 1: Is it appropriate to classify an unattended self-service car wash facility

with drive-in bays for an individual to wash their own vehicle as a Group

B occupancy? If no, is there a more appropriate classification?

ANSWER: Yes, "carwash" is a specific category listed under Section 304

Business Group B.

QUESTION 2: Is a an unattended self-service car wash facility with drive-in bays for an

individual to wash their own vehicle considered an occupied building

that is required to be provided with public toilet facilities?

ANSWER: No. Section 2902.1 provides plumbing fixtures "based on the actual

use of the building." Uses not shown on Table 2902.1 "shall be

considered individually by the code official." A self-service car wash with no employees and no occupant load for the purpose of means of egress facilities is not covered on Table 2902.1 Minimum Number of

Required Plumbing Fixtures.
