STATE BUILDING CODE INTERPRETATION NO. 18-12

- CODE: 2015 Washington State Energy Code, Commercial
- **SECTION:** C404.9 Domestic hot water meters
- QUESTION: Does Section C404.9 apply to individual *dormitory* dwelling units in a Group R-2 building where all units are held in common ownership by a public institution?
- ANSWER: Yes, if the dormitory is set up as a dwelling unit as defined by the code, with integral kitchen and bathing facilities. If they are set up more in the manner of sleeping units, they would not be required to provide meters.
