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## STATE BUILDING CODE INTERPRETATION NO. 19-02

- **CODE:** 2015 International Building Code
- **SECTION:** 1104.4
- **QUESTION 1:** Can portions of the second floor be subtracted in order to calculate the square footage of the floor with regard to the accessible route?
- ANSWER: No. Exception 1 defines aggregate area. Aggregate area is defined to mean the area as a whole or mass.
- **QUESTION 2:** Do you calculate the square footage for the accessible route based on Gross or Net SF?
- ANSWER: Floor Area Gross would be in line with the required aggregate area.
- QUESTION 3: Can you subtract equipment spaces per Section 1103.2.9?
- ANSWER: No, Section 1103.2.9 only allows it to be exempt from the requirement, not as a square foot deduction.
