## STATE BUILDING CODE INTERPRETATION NO. 98-12

**CODE:** 1997 Uniform Plumbing Code

**SECTION:** 608.5 Exception

**QUESTIONS:** 1. Is it the intent of the exception to exempt equipment on any

floor, i.e., floors above the first habitable floor, from the

requirement to connect to an approved drain?

2. When a replacement water heater is installed in a space

provided with a drain discharging to the exterior of the building, is

reconnecting to that drain required?

ANSWERS: 1. Yes, if the equipment is replacement equipment.

2. Yes. Replacing a water heater is simply replacing one part

of an existing "plumbing system" (see UPC Definitions, Section

21.0) and the original system connections should be

maintained. The exception is intended to apply where there is

no existing drain.
