<u>1436</u>	State building code council	Buys, Blake, Taylor, Springer, Short, Pike	SBCC directed to revise process for statewide and local amendments, create procedure for approval of products & materials, work with office of CIO on cost benefit of technology to better enhance access to process; separates out membership into Public/Private sector; moves contracting and employment to DES; establishes task force on SBCC; adds SBCC to “significant rules” section of APA; amends vesting language to specify architect & engineer requirements locked at application	H State Gov

February 17, 2017	Last day to read in committee reports (pass bills out of committee) in the house of origin, except House fiscal committees and Senate Ways & Means and Transportation committees.
February 24, 2017	Last day to read in committee reports (pass bills out of committee) from House fiscal committees and Senate Ways & Means and Transportation committees in house of origin
March 8, 2017	Last day to consider bills in house of origin.
March 29, 2017	Last day to read in committee reports (pass bills out of committee) from the opposite house, except House fiscal committees and Senate Ways & Means and Transportation committees.
April 4, 2017	Last day to read in opposite house committee reports (pass bills out of committee) from House fiscal committees and Senate Ways & Means and Transportation committees
April 12, 2017	Last day to consider opposite house bills (except initiatives, budgets and matters necessary to implement budgets, and matters of differences between the two houses)
