SECTION: C405, Simulated Performance Alternative

QUESTION: Would the use of Section R405 to show compliance still require the

additional energy credits from Section R406?

ANSWER: Yes. Projects showing compliance with the energy code via the

performance method would still need to comply with the appropriate

number of credits in Section R406.3.
