4. Cost Benefit Analysis  • WSEC-Commercial	Stoyan Bumbalov explained the code adoption process, including the development of the Preliminary Cost Benefit Analysis and the Final Cost Benefit Analysis. He specified the scope of work for the Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL) to develop a third-party final cost benefit report. Stoyan Bumbalov clarified the Committee members could ask clarifying questions of PNNL. It was also noted that the PNNL report discussed at the meeting is a preliminary draft and public comment would be limited.  Rob Salcido, PNNL, provided an overview of the PNNL Analysis. He indicated there was limited time spent on the analysis.  Committee members asked clarifying questions, which were
	answered by Rob Salcido. Members of the public asked questions about the report and provided comments. Discussion ensued on the report by Committee members, Council members, PNNL representatives and the public.
