Agenda Items	Committee Actions/Discussion
1. Welcome and Introductions	(10:00 a.m.) The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Todd Beyreuther, Committee Chair. Everyone was welcomed and roll was called. A quorum of the Committee was present.
2. Review and Approve Agenda	(10:04 a.m.) Motion: Al Spaulding made a motion to approve the agenda as drafted. Michael Barth seconded the motion. A voice vote was taken, and the motion passed with no opposition.
3. Off-Cycle Rule: Continue Discussion for Adoption of R-4 Occupancy Group	 (10:04 a.m.) Stoyan Bumbalov introduced the continued discussion for the adoption of the R-4 Occupancy Group. Stoyan Bumbalov also inquired if an additional meeting of the Fire TAG would be necessary to complete the review process. Continued discussion began at IBC Section 1017.
	(10:16 a.m.) Discussions on sections contained within WAC ended and discussions on references to R-4 not contained in WAC began. The Council staff requested guidance for TAG to determine if these sections need any amendments.

	(10:30 a.m.) Ardel Jala raised concern in the difference between R-4 Condition 1 vs R-4 Condition 2 and the separation requirements from corridors. Ron Wright asked that the classification of Dwelling vs Sleeping unit be included in the definitions section. Further discussion was had on this topic.
	(11:13 a.m.) Motion: Al Spaulding made a motion to keep the sentence in Section 420.2 as depicted in the draft. Michael Barth seconded the motion. Additional discussion was had. A voice vote was taken, and the motion passed with no opposition.
	(11:23 a.m.) Discussion continued for the remaining sections of the 2021 International Building Code.
	(11:31 a.m.) Motion: Al Spaulding made a motion to recommend the full draft of IBC language, as edited at this meeting, to be referred to the Building Fire and Plumbing Committee. Michael Barth Seconded the motion. Additional discussion was had. A roll call vote was taken. The motion passed with no opposition.
