Agenda Items	Committee Actions/Discussion
Welcome and Introductions	(10:00 a.m.) The meeting was called to order by Todd Beyreuther, Building Code TAG Chair. Everyone was welcomed and roll was called. A quorum of both the Building Code and Fire Code TAGs was present.
	(10:04 a.m.) Todd Beyreuther and Stoyan Bumbalov reviewed the purpose of this joint meeting of the Building Code and Fire Code TAGs. The goal being to recommend to the State Building Code Council draft language for the 2021 IBC and IFC adopting the R-4 Occupancy Classification.
2. Review and Approve Agenda	(10:08 a.m.) <b>Motion:</b> Dave Kokot made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Allen Spaulding seconded the motion. A voice vote was taken, and the motion passed with no opposition.
Off-Cycle Rule: Continue     Discussion for Adoption of     R-4 Occupancy Group	(10:09 a.m.) Stoyan Bumbalov reintroduced the topic of adopting the R-4 Occupancy into the 2021 IBC and IFC.

	Discussion began recapping the outcome of the IFC TAG meeting held on April 12, 2023.
	(10:34 a.m.) <b>Motion:</b> Ken Brouillette made a motion to include the changes of ICC proposal G5021 for the 2024 IBC into both the 2021 IBC and IFC. This proposal modifies the definition of "Custodial Care" and adds a definition for "Limited Verbal or Physical Assistance". Allen Spaulding seconded the motion. A voice vote was taken, and the motion passed with no opposition.
	(10:35 a.m.) Discussion continued on additional sections of the IBC language. Sections 420.2, 903, 1107.2, and 1108.6.4.3.3 were discussed at great length.
	(11:35 a.m.) <b>Motion:</b> Allen Spaulding made a motion to include Section 1108.6.4.3.3 and the exception in the draft language document without modification for clarity. Quyen Thai seconded the motion. A voice vote was taken, and the motion passed with no opposition.
	(11:36 a.m.) Discussion continued on sections of the IBC.
	(11:42 a.m.) <b>Motion:</b> Roger Heeringa made a motion to strike an exception to section 1107.2. This exception was included by mistake and duplicated the exception above. Chris Seaman seconded the motion. A voice vote was taken, and the motion passed with no opposition.
	(11:45 a.m.) <b>Motion:</b> Allen Spaulding made a motion to refer the draft of both the IBC and IFC language as edited in this meeting to the State Building Code Council. Michael Barth seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken from both the Building Code and Fire Code TAGs. The motion passed unanimously in both groups.
