Purpose: This emergency filing is needed to reinstate an amendment erroneously removed from the 2021 International Fire Code during the 2021 initial rule making (2021 Code Adoption Cycle).

EMERGENCY RULE

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds:

- That immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.
- That state or federal law or federal rule or a federal deadline for state receipt of federal funds requires immediate adoption of a rule.

Reasons for this finding: During the drafting of the proposed amendments to WAC 51-54A (2021 International Fire Code) a transcription error was made, having the effect of removing the existing Washington State amendment to Section 308.1.4. The removal was not proposed by the IFC Technical Advisory Group nor the Building, Fire, and Plumbing Standing Committee, and it was unintended by the council.
